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A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

It's that time of year for scholarships! At ASHE Harrisburg, the scholarships we provide are a large part of what we do. Why is it so important? Did you know the average annual cost of college tuition has risen at 7 percent a year since 2000, outpacing inflation at 2.5 percent? You can essentially multiply tuition by 4 and that doesn't include room, board, books and fees.

When I first joined the scholarship committee around 2019, we were reviewing about 70 applications every year. I asked the Board how many of the recipients we end up hiring? The response astonished me, only one full time hire in the past decade. How could that be? We are doing all of the work reviewing applications and providing opportunities for these students to go to school, so why aren't we recruiting them when our industry needs it so much? Our focus has since shifted to do just this. Did you know that in 2022, we added a checkbox to ask if it is okay for scholarship applicants to be contacted for future employment opportunities? If any of our Century Club Members are interested in our list of highly qualified scholarship applicants, we are happy to provide it.

Last year, the scholarship committee led by Virginia Bailey, consisting of Alan Williamson, myself, Joe Sutor and Danielle Derolf provided 12 scholarships totaling \$25,000. The scholarship committee has worked tirelessly every year to improve the process and seek the most qualified candidates possible. Annually, ASHE National compiles a list of scholarships provided by all 49 ASHE sections, with 18 of those sections in the Northeast Region. With the generous amount of \$25,000 from our membership, our section offered the 2nd most amount of money of all the sections. The average of all 49 sections was approximately \$7,000. With rising costs, it is nice to see our section doing what we can to help others.

But, our interaction with students isn't limited to just our scholarships. ASHE Harrisburg has made it a mission to engage student chapters, provide opportunities, and recruit students into our workforce. After all, we're already doing the work, so let's retain this future talent in the great state of Pennsylvania. To date, Eric Martz helped establish a student chapter at Shippensburg University and Kyle Hostetter, Mark Lemon and Kevin Starner have routinely engaged Elizabethtown College, PSU Harrisburg, HACC, York College and Messiah University.

Contacts with local area schools provide opportunities for our industry to engage students. ETown has even hinted at allowing us to utilize their venue for meetings or events. We would love to help facilitate the setup of information sessions or recruitment events for our Century Club Members at these universities.

Let's keep moving the needle at ASHE Harrisburg and in our industry! I hope to see you at our next ASHE Event.

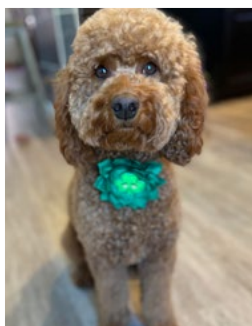
