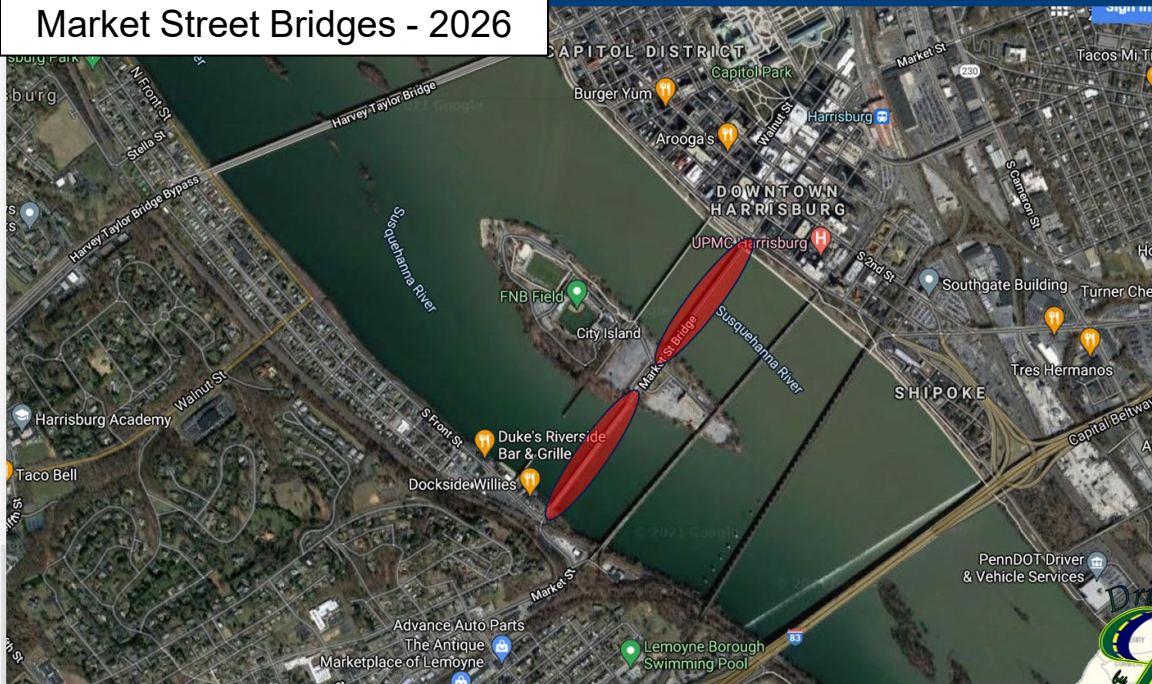

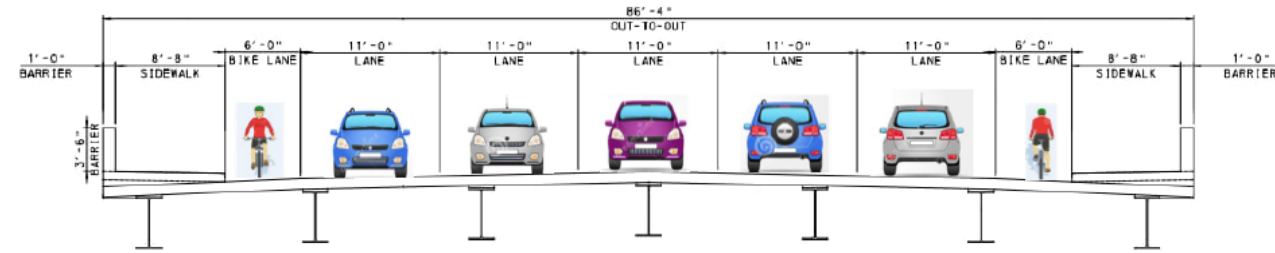

Existing 4-Lane Roadway



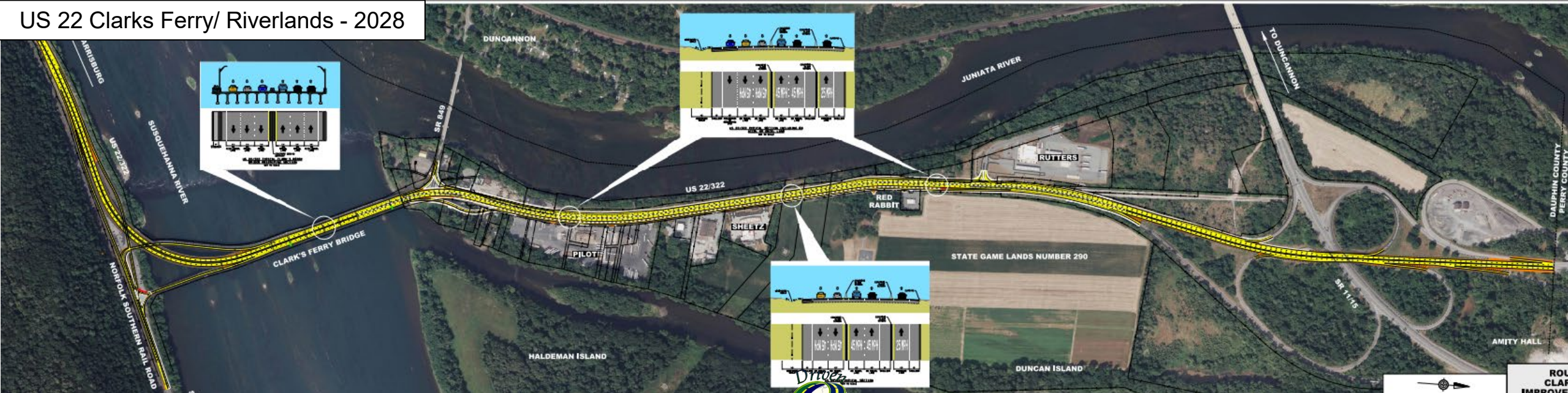
Proposed 5-Lane Roadway with Bike Lanes

I-83 North York (Codus Section) - 2026

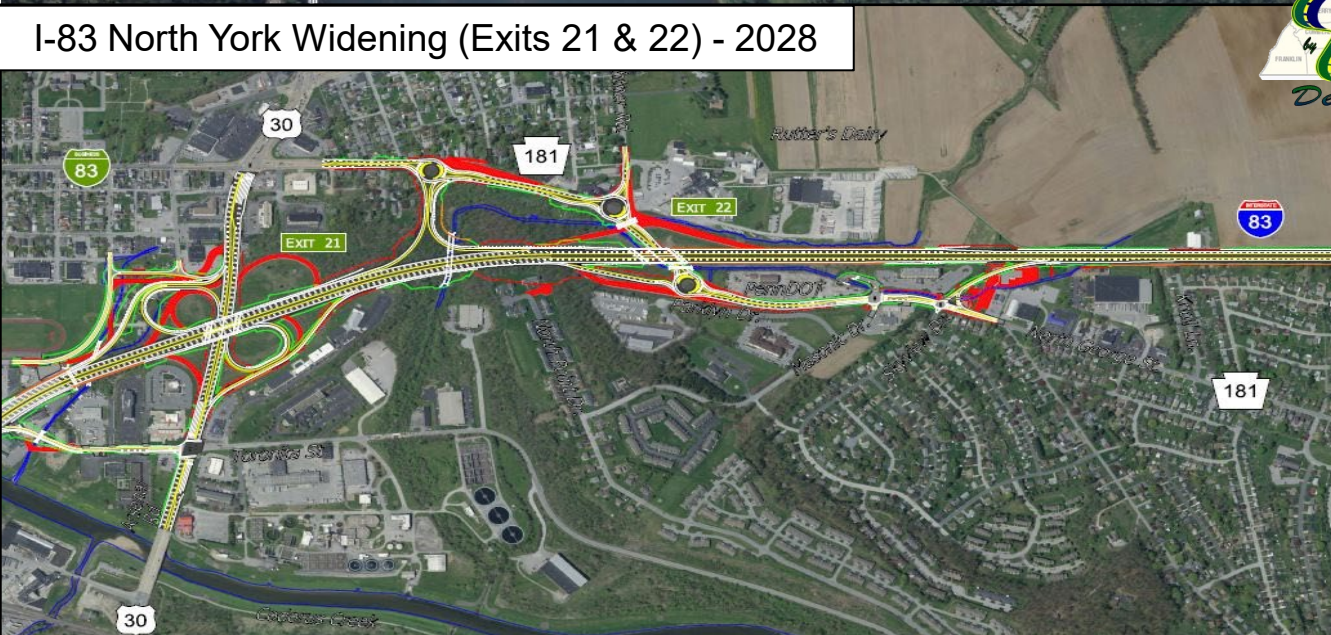

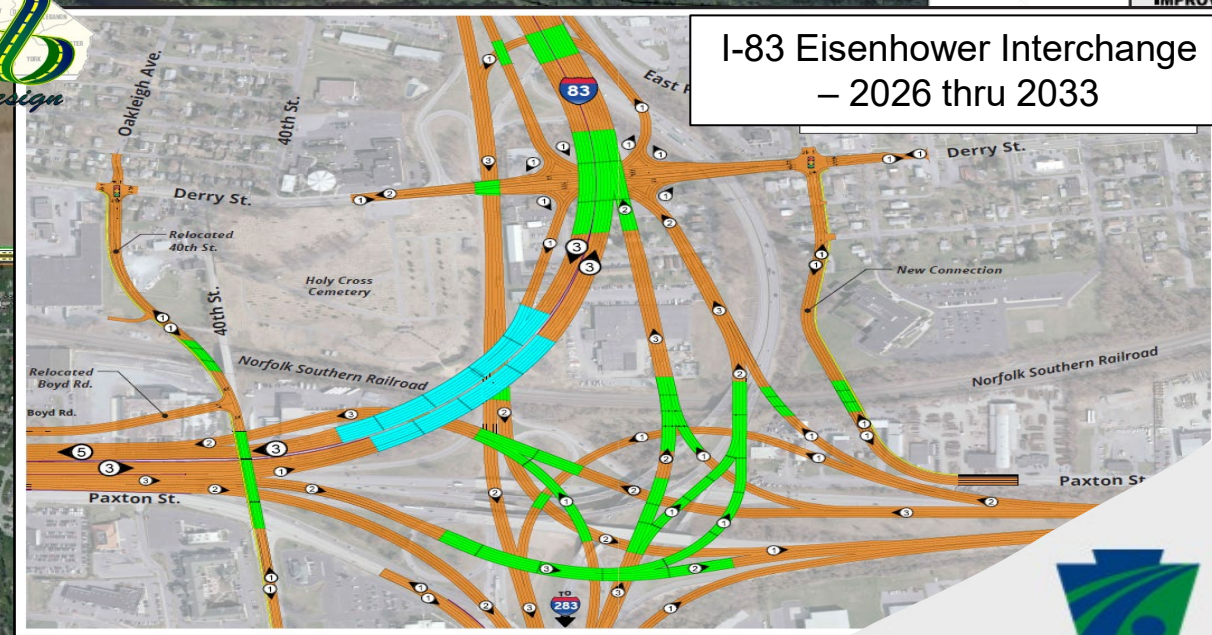
US 22 Clarks Ferry/ Riverlands - 2028



I-83 North York Widening (Exits 21 & 22) - 2028

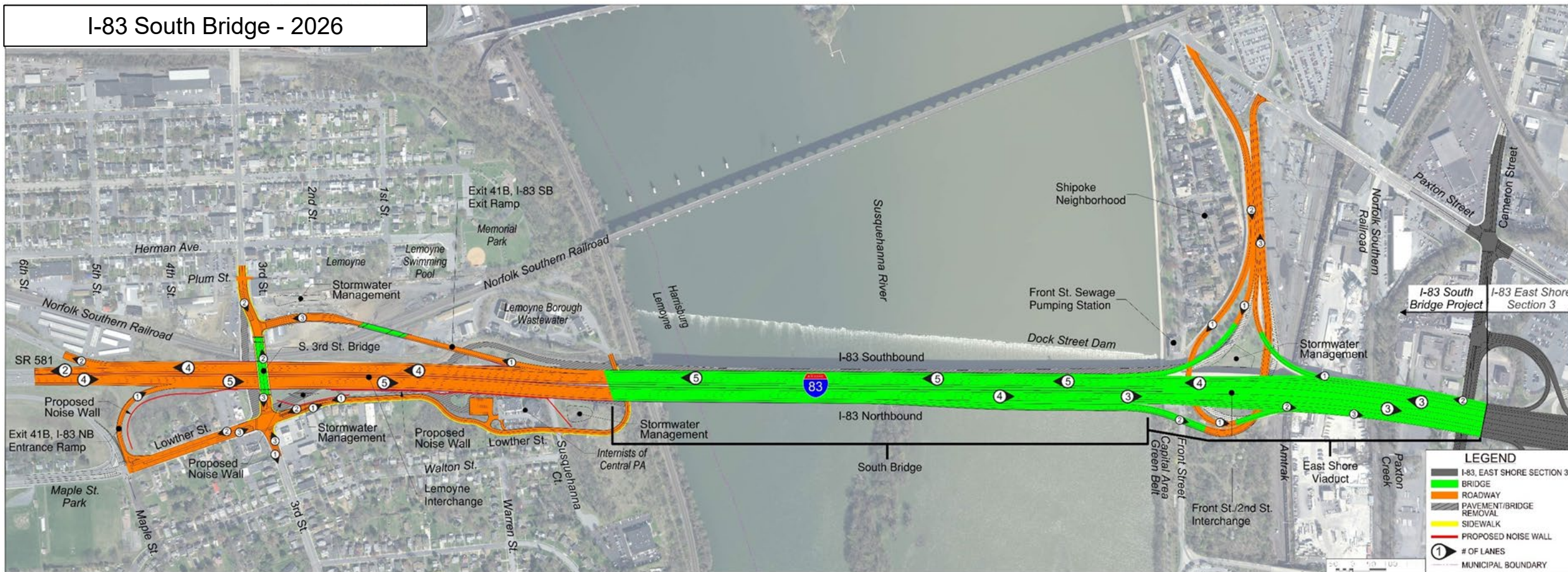


I-83 Eisenhower Interchange - 2026 thru 2033

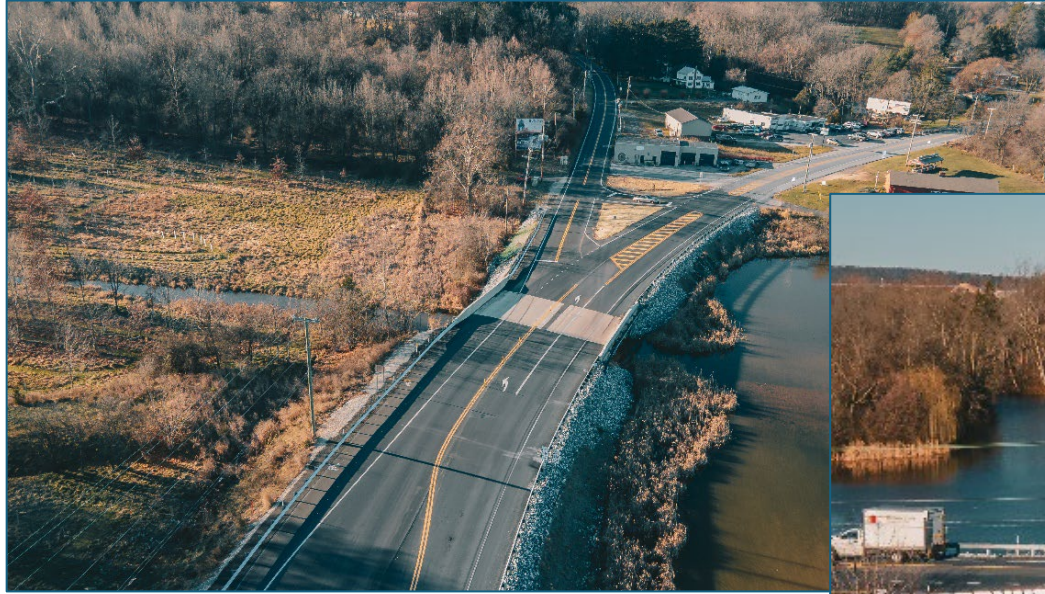

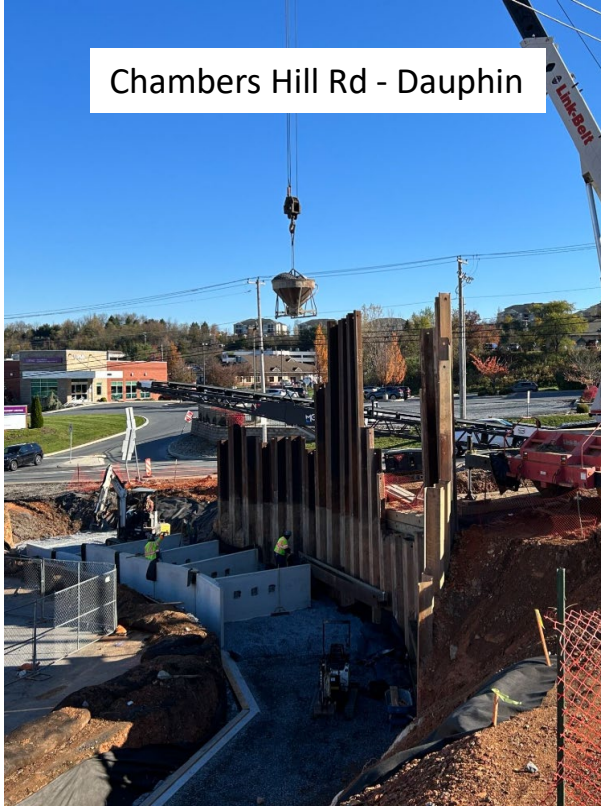


I-83 Resurfacing George Street to PA 921

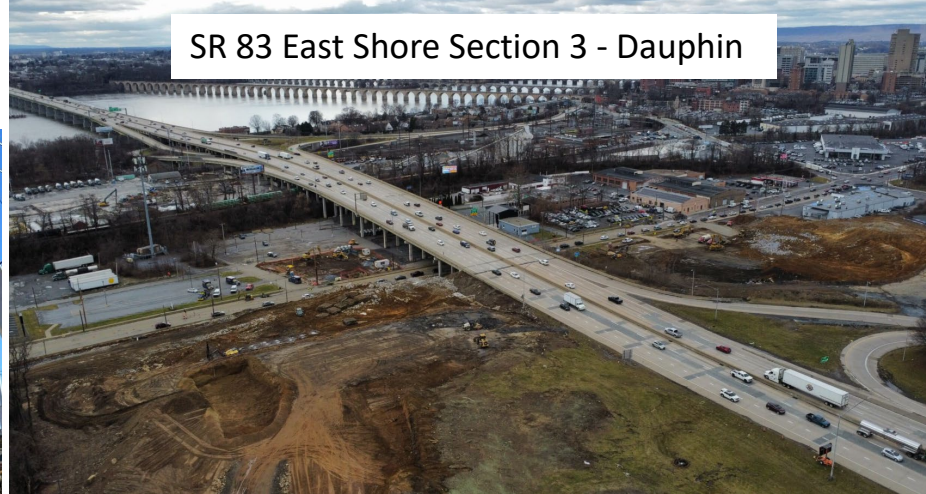

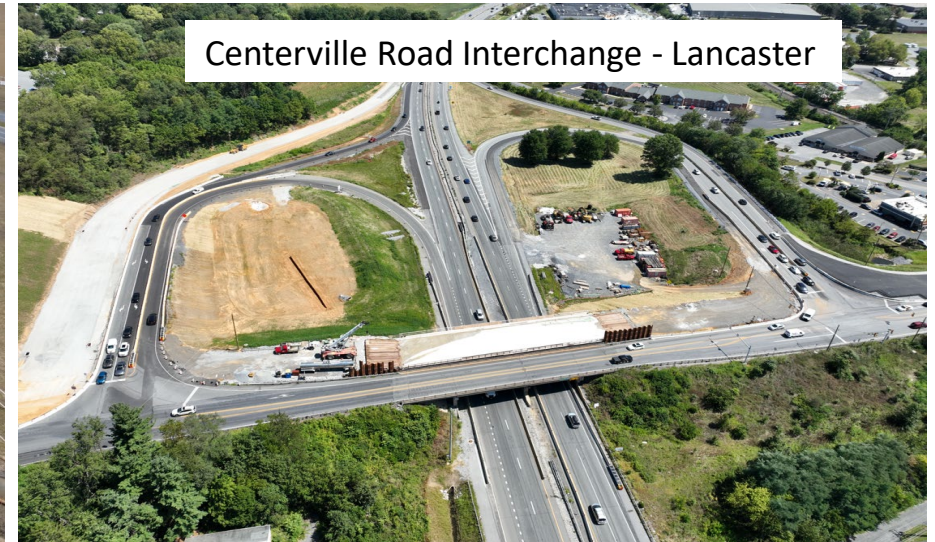

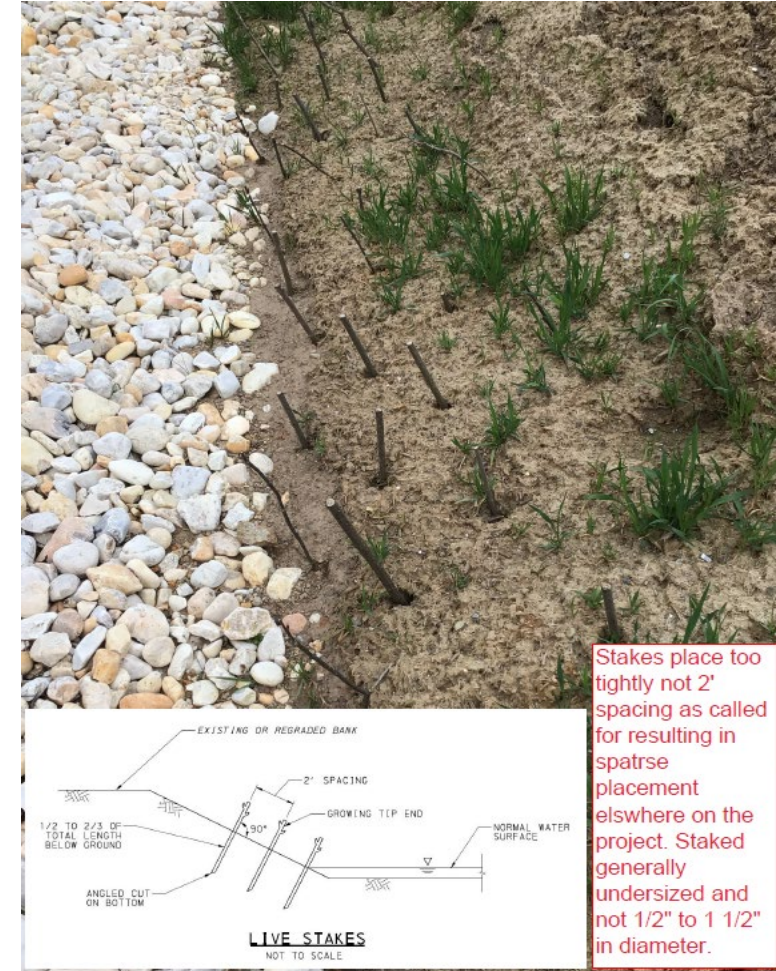

GREATER EMPHASIS ON PLANTINGS

- Reoccurring issues with plantings and seeding
- Mandatory pre-planting and pre-seeding meetings with contractor
- Special provisions being added to contracts for watering, herbicides application, and mowing



CHAPTER 102 RENEWAL-NPDES GENERAL PERMITS

- **VSIR Requirements**

- App was updated to include new inspection requirements (Late December 2024)

- **Designee Changes**

- Designee overseeing the work must be independent from the operator (co-permittee) responsible for the construction or installation of SCMs on a project site

- **SCM Sign-Offs**

- DEP's SCM Construction Certification Form must be completed and submitted to DEP/CCD within 30 days of construction completion for each SCM
 - Central Office developed Standard SP to incorporate new permit language
 - A new submittal type will be added to PPCC for contractors to upload the form
 - ADE of Construction will sign the form

ADE DESIGN NOTES

- Middle of '25-'28 TIP update cycle
 - Planning Staff and MPOs starting work on '27 TIP update
 - Indications now are that funding levels will remain flat
 - FFY 26 funding must be obligated by 9/30/2026 (actually prior to Labor Day blackout)
- CE Expert System was updated on 4/10/25 to address Presidential Executive Orders related to Environmental Justice (still need to comply with state laws relating to permitting)
- Planning to Publish Unofficial plans for our projects that are ~\$200M or greater moving forward



ESTIMATES

- For 2025 thus far averaging a few % under bid
 - Statewide is about 0.6% over ECMS estimate
 - Hard to predict future given financial market uncertainty & impacts of tariffs
- What can we do?
 - Monitor/review estimates often (watch cost drivers like steel)
 - Reduce last minute (PS&E) surprises
 - Increases may require MPO/CPDM/PMC approval before letting
 - Fall 2024 started a District PMC process



DISTRICT PMC PROCESS

- Projects with significant changes in scope or cost increases are presented for management review and approval with the following thresholds:
 - Design Unit Cost Increase - \$250K or 10% of phase cost
 - Construction Cost Increase – Lesser of \$250K or 10% over contract amount
 - New project requests, including TIP or Maintenance funded appropriations
 - Scope of work changes that result in cost increase to any phase
 - Requests for use of consultant services (open-end, new agreement, etc)
 - Other unique project issues requiring decisions at the executive level as determined by the respective ADE.
- Monthly Committee meeting administered by District Planning staff
